U.S. Small Arms Training School recently field tested the U.S. made AK47-C Rifle, 7.62 x 39 - **LIBERTY offered by I.O. Inc., www.ioinc.us, located in Monroe, NC. The school was seeking an alternate lower cost – high quality semi-auto weapon to occasionally train with. The school traditionally trains with the U.S. made M16/M4/AR-15 type rifles during patrol rifle and close quarter combat training. Instructors had students test the rifle at random during various courses taught at the school. The student skill level ranged from a basic marksman to expert, from domestic to law enforcement S.W.A.T. team members. The same rifle was used by all students. We are happy to report that 2500 rounds of Golden Tiger 7.62x39 124 Grain lead core, steel case FMJBT was used during the field test with no hang ups or jams. The rifle was intentionally not cleaned between uses.**

Students and staff members commented on how quick, easy and smooth it was to accurately engage the target. The average group average was 2" within a 3- 4" circle from center mass at 75 yards. The rifle was accurate right out of the box without any modifications. The rifle tested weighed 6 pounds equipped with a U.S. polymer stock, pistol grip and tactical rail handguard. The rifles overall length is 36" with a 16-1/4" barrel. A polymer 30 round magazine that came included with the rifle was used during the testing without any issues.
